Hoop earrings are jewelry with a rounded shape that loops through an ear piercing. They are usually circular, but hoops can also be more oval or geometric. There are many types of [hoop earrings](#) including inside out hoops, chunky hoops, dangle hoops, and huggies.

Classic hoop earrings symbolize style, wealth, status, and beauty. Circular hoops are the most popular shape for these earrings. Hoops are often designed in gold, silver or platinum. These earrings are secured through the wearer's ear piercing and have a looped dangling component. The size of hoop earrings can vary from large to small.



All About Huggies



Huggie earrings are small hoop earrings. They have the same shape and closure as larger hoops but with a smaller diameter that holds the earring closer to the wearer's earlobe. [Huggie earrings](#) are shorter than other hoops, hugging the wearer's earlobe rather than dangling lower like larger hoops often do.

Small huggie earrings are popular for [earring stacking](#) or solo wear. They're perfect for any occasion, adding a touch of glam to every ensemble. Smaller huggies are also often lighter than larger hoops, making them a great fit for wearers with sensitive ears.

Similarities Between Huggies And Hoops



Huggies and hoops share more similarities than differences. This is because huggies are hoop earrings, they just have smaller diameters. Both huggies and hoops feature wraparound designs and use [precious](#)

[metals](#), [diamonds](#) and [gemstones](#). Hoops and huggies are popular for every budget and style.

Differences Between Huggies And Hoops

Diameter is the main difference between huggie earrings and hoop earrings. Huggies have a smaller diameter than hoops, sitting closer to the wearer's earlobe. This smaller diameter means that huggies fit more tightly to the ear than hoops, but both styles are still comfortable for frequent wear.

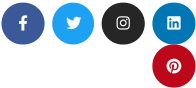
